Intent:

At Westbury Academy, our Modern Foreign Languages (MFL) curriculum is delivered through enriching, inclusive experiences that promote curiosity, communication, and cultural awareness. MFL at Westbury is explored through drop-down days, themed events, and immersive cultural experiences designed to be accessible and meaningful to all pupils.

Rather than focusing on a single language, our MFL provision introduces pupils to a range of languages and forms of communication, helping them to recognise diversity and celebrate global cultures. Opportunities to explore spoken languages, sign languages such as British Sign Language (BSL), and non-verbal forms of communication are offered through activities across the academic year.

Our approach is tailored to meet the needs of our SEND learners. Pupils develop confidence in expressing themselves, an appreciation of cultural differences, and a growing awareness of the world beyond their own community. These experiences also reinforce key personal development themes; respect, identity, and inclusive communication, while supporting **Preparation for Adulthood**.

MFL at Westbury provides purposeful opportunities for pupils to explore language and culture in a way that supports their curiosity, communication skills, and growing **Independence**.
