Intent:

At Westbury Academy, our Music curriculum nurtures creativity, expression, and confidence, while developing the knowledge and skills pupils need for **Independence** and **Preparation for Adulthood**. Through performing, composing, and listening, pupils build fluency in musical elements such as rhythm, pitch, structure, and dynamics.

Music is delivered through Nottingham Music Hub and Curriculum Maestro in Years 3-8, providing inclusive, engaging opportunities to explore instruments, voice, and musical traditions. In Year 9, pupils follow an internal curriculum that builds independence, digital composition skills, and musical understanding.

In KS4 pupils can access a vocational music production pathway in partnership with Education & Bass, working towards Rockschoool Awards (RSL). Across all stages, music promotes collaboration, cultural awareness, and a lifelong appreciation of the arts.
